- Instead of 4/3, 4/2 will now be the last day to turn in physical work at the school.
- Next week, 4/6-4/10, will be treated as our originally planned SPRING BREAK.
- Students/Teachers will commence with instruction on 4/13.
- Mr. Travis is working on student WW email accounts. Teachers will use student WW email for communication.
- Bloomz, email, Zoom, Google classroom, etc. will be used (and is already being used) for instruction/assignment delivery.
- Schedule/Structure will resemble the following:
 - Lower School teachers available 10-1 Monday-Thursday. Teachers may deliver content, answer questions via email, Bloomz, phone, etc. Completed work for each day will count as attendance for that day.
 - MS/HS 1st, 2nd, 3rd period to be held on Monday & Wednesday. 4th, 5th, 6th to be held on Tuesday & Thursday. Fridays will be open for DE/AP classes or private sessions with students as needed. Classes to be approx. 40 min, in order to accommodate transitions. Teachers will use various platforms/media to deliver instruction/assignments. Students will be asked to check-in via email, video, text, etc. to mark attendance.
 - Students will need to contact teachers via their WW email by 4/10 in order to facilitate instruction/communication when school reconvenes on 4/13.
