Curriculum/College Guidance – Dicksy Hinesley

- SAT currently there are 7 seniors who have not taken SAT, however, 3 of those 7 are new students whom which Dicksy has not yet been given access to those records. There are a few juniors who have not taken the SAT.
- ACT we typically receive a "college readiness" letter early fall each year. As of today, we have not received a letter.
