Supplies for your middle school English class with Ms. Deana:



- A 1 1/2" <u>WHITE</u> Heavy Duty binder and a 1 subject spiral notebook
- A 3 ring zipper pencil bag to be placed inside your binder for the purpose of storing highlighters and study cards
- O 5 Quality **Dividers** Plastic dividers with pockets are ideal.
- O You will probably need one pack or less of loose leaf notebook **paper** this year.
- You will need the following **highlighters**: Pink, Yellow, Blue, Green, Orange, and Purple. You will use these in class daily. Please make sure you keep a supply of these colors. They are a requirement.
- O Index cards will be very useful in English class. Ms. Deana asks that you bring 2 packs of white cards (lined or unlined) and 2 packs of colored cards (lined or unlined). You will store these in your classroom. 3x5 cards are most useful.
- You will complete your classroom assignments in pencil. Ms. Deana asks that you use mechanical pencils. You may write with any color pens of your choice when taking class notes and making study cards.
- You will need a pack of **metal "O" rings** (see example) to help you organize your study cards. These are a requirement. Rubber bands are not allowed.
- Please have a small pack of clear page protectors. These are useful for grammar guides and special writing projects.
- Ms. Deana keeps a supply of various art supplies in her room. Each year she asks the students to bring one item to help keep the room stocked and ready for interactive fun. This year she asks the <u>6th grade girls</u> to bring **Elmer's glue sticks** (a pack of 2 or 3 would be great), <u>6th grade boys</u> to bring a **metal one hole puncher**, the <u>7th grade girls</u> to bring a small pack of regular **high temp hot glue sticks**, the <u>7th grade boys</u> to bring a pack of **Post-It sticky notes**, the <u>8th grade girls</u> to bring a bottle of **rubber cement**, and the <u>8th grade boys</u> to bring a pair of **scissors** (Any size / good used condition is sufficient).
