- b. Thornless Key Lime – The Thornless key lime is an ornamental tree with fragrant white flowers, deep green leaves and yellow-green fruit. It makes a great patio tree. You will enjoy trying different ways to use your harvest. You can zest the peeling, juice the fruit for cocktails and pies or grind the leaves for aromatherapy, potpourri and soaps.
- c. Variegated Pink Lemon – Just like the more common, non-pink Eureka lemon, these colorful citrus fruits boast a tart, lip-puckering flavor. However, pink lemons become less acidic as they age, meaning they typically offer a sweeter flavor than what you'd expect from a lemon. They look sensational poolside in a big pot.
